**RETURN CHECK POLICY:**

A bad check will be charged a \$20.00 service fee. Registration/enrollment will be cancelled and withdrawn. To re-register, the \$20.00 charge plus the tuition fee in cash or money order only. New registration form will be taken based on new submittal date.

**REFUND POLICY:**

Students will receive a refund based on the following:

Full Refund: Notification must be received before June 15, 2009

50% Refund: Notification must be received by June 17, 2009

25% Refund: Notification must be received by June 24, 2009.

No refund shall be made after June 24, 2009.

Students who wish to withdraw must notify the school office and return their books.

**RULES & REGULATIONS FOR SUMMER SCHOOL**

**ATTENDANCE:**

Attendance in summer school is crucial, each day of summer school is equivalent to one week of the regular school year. The interaction between teacher and student is a basic fundamental skill. *All absences will be weighted equally, excused or unexcused.* Please make arrangements for doctor's appointments after the school day, and family trips after the summer school session. Attendance will be taken daily. Students with three (3) absences or five (5) tardies during summer school may be released from summer school. If a student is not in class for one hour or more, it will be considered an absence. 2 tardies will be considered as 1 absence.

**STUDENT DISCIPLINE:**

Regular school rules pertaining to conduct must be observed during summer school. The provisions of Chapter 19 on Student Discipline will be enforced. Student misconduct may result in dismissal from the Summer School program. Any student dismissed for reasons of misconduct or non-attendance will forfeit their complete tuition. The student will receive NO CREDIT for the portion of the session already attended.
